Myanmar:

Please pray for God's miraculous intervention in the ongoing crisis in Myanmar. The Civil War rages on and the Junta seems determined to crush any resistance to their power. Human suffering is at unprecedented levels and the UN now says criminal networks are out of control as the desperation for food and other essential supplies borders on catastrophic. Two million people are at risk of starvation in Rakhine state. Pray for safety for Rebecca and for Khin, our new coordinators there. Pray that we can continue to support them and that their internet would not be cut off.

Ukraine:

Civilians continue to die from rocket and drone attacks. Those who do not die physically are dying a little more emotionally every day. Every one of our trainers have lost loved ones or they know someone fighting on the frontline. Please pray that the new Trump administration would bring Putin and Zelenskyy together and find a solution to this crisis and suffering but also, one that does not succeed any more territory to Russia.

Pray for my friend pastor Sasha. Sasha mentors hundreds of pastors and he is helping us manage the deployment of our largest trauma healing project in Ukraine. Sasha was recently called up for arms. The Army has given him an exemption from service for now. Please pray that he is permanently free from military service so he can keep shepherding the church and helping us during such a critical time. Pray also for his wife Raya who leads a refuge for displaced women and children, a ministry we are also seeking to support.
